

TONALITY

- · As a reaction to the Middle Ages Church Scales, and with the event of the Equal Temperament System, the Tonality appeared during the 17th Century and lived through what is called <u>Common Practice Period</u>; It "simplifies" the old multiple MODE Systems to just two: Major and minor, freely transposable and sounding alike on any of the 12 chromatic steps
- \cdot <u>TONALITY</u> or <u>KEY</u> = a system of hierarchical relationships "revolving" around a central pitch or <u>TONIC</u>; the Tonality is the <u>Creative</u> factor- pieces "go" in a certain key
